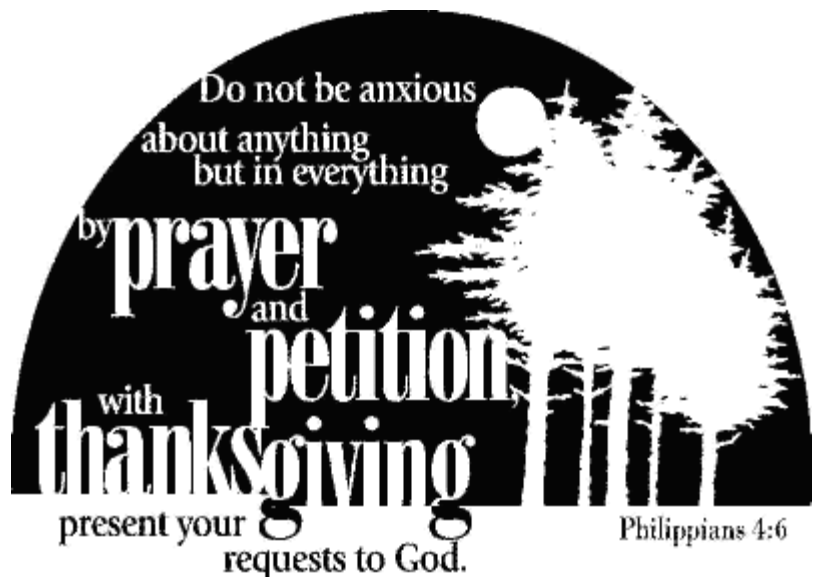





Around a decade ago, a group from the congregation started putting up an extra tree in the back of the sanctuary at Christmas time.

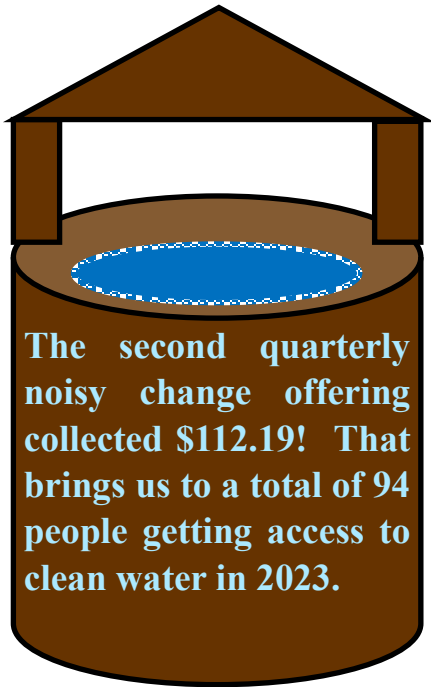

**Lake Worship will run July 9th through August 13th. We will gather at 8 AM in the open shelter north of the lake.**  
 This year we will *not* end the Lake Worship season with a picnic. We will have an event several weeks later at the church building instead. More details to come next month.

There will be a quick **Missions** and Outreach Committee **meeting after worship** on Father's Day—**June 18<sup>th</sup>**. It will be a quick review of missions as well as an update on where we are financially.



The second quarterly noisy change offering collected \$112.19! That brings us to a total of 94 people getting access to clean water in 2023.

*The Way* (middle and high school students) are planning and fundraising for a July 24 – 30 trip to Ohio/Kentucky. The trip will include seeing the Ark, service projects and witnessing.

They are working on keeping the costs low, but are still looking at \$500-600 per person with about a dozen teens and adults planning on going. They will be bussing tables at Pizza Ranch June 5th and June 19th during the supper hours.

**Technical notes**

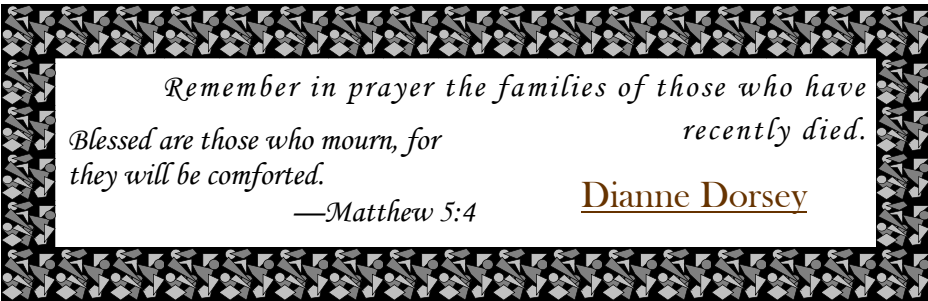
